THE MODULAR TRAINING SYSTEM

The modular route to a Commercial Pilot's Licence is the most cost-effective and practical method for most people. It entails taking a series of modules:

1. The Private Pilot's Licence (PPL) and Night Rating
2. Ground School for the Theoretical Knowledge Written Examinations
3. The Commercial Pilot's Licence (CPL) Modular Course
4. The Instrument Rating (IR) Modular Course
5. The Multi Crew Co-operation (MCC) Course

The CPL/MULTI ENGINE COURSE

The aim of the CPL modular course is to train PPL holders to a standard that will enable them to pass the skill test for the Commercial Pilot's Licence. The module consists of at least 28 hours training in general handling, instrument flying and navigation. The first phase of the training is carried out in single engine aircraft, but a minimum of 8 hours plus the skill test must be carried out in a multi engine aircraft. At Multiflight we utilise the twin engine Beech Duchess to fulfil this requirement.

THE INSTRUMENT RATING (IR) MODULAR COURSE

The aim of the Instrument Rating (IR) modular course is to train PPL or CPL holders to a standard that will allow them to pass the IR skill test and operate aeroplanes under instrument flight rules and in instrument meteorological conditions. The IR module consists of 45/55 hours training of which up to 30/40 hours may be carried out in our FNPT II. The FNPT II is an extremely realistic synthetic training device (STD) with full visuals. The remaining flight training is carried out in the Beech Duchess for the multi-engine IR. At Multiflight we recommend that the CPL module be completed prior to the IR module.

IR RENEWALS/CONVERSIONS

We offer Instrument Renewals for those students whose IR has lapsed in either the simulator or an aeroplane. We can also offer foreign licence and rating conversions.

THE MCC COURSE

The Multi Crew Co-operation Course is designed to introduce pilots to the different techniques required when flying multi crew aircraft. The course starts with 3 days ground school followed by 5 days of rostered simulator training. This is carried out in an FNPT II configured as a Beech 200 King Air. The FNPT II is an extremely realistic synthetic training device with full visuals. We can also offer Instrument Rating renewals as an optional extra to the course for those students whose IR has lapsed.

AB-INITIO ATPL

The Ab-Initio ATPL Course is aimed at those students wishing to obtain a professional pilot's licence as quickly as possible. The course is designed to take the potential professional pilot with no flying experience through the modular training required to gain their CPL/IR with ATPL Theoretical Knowledge credits in approximately 14 months. It effectively takes the student through the modular route to a commercial licence and includes all the flying hours between modules for CPL/IR issue. This is carefully structured in order to make the process as quick and cost-effective as possible.

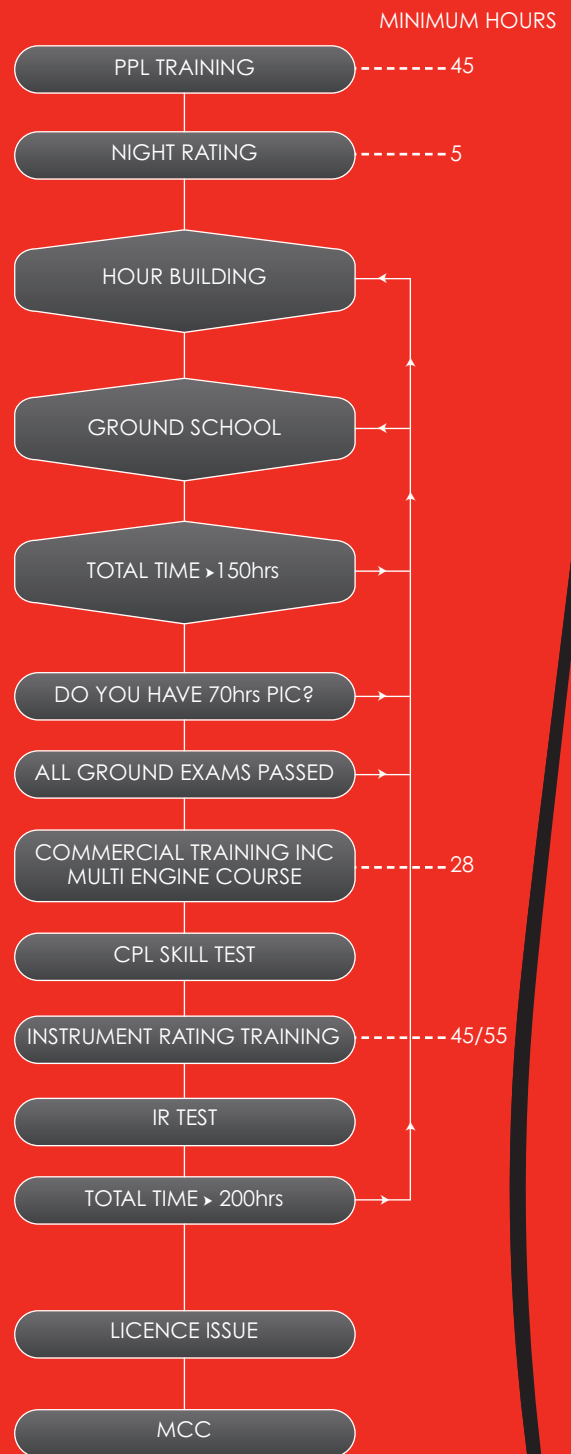

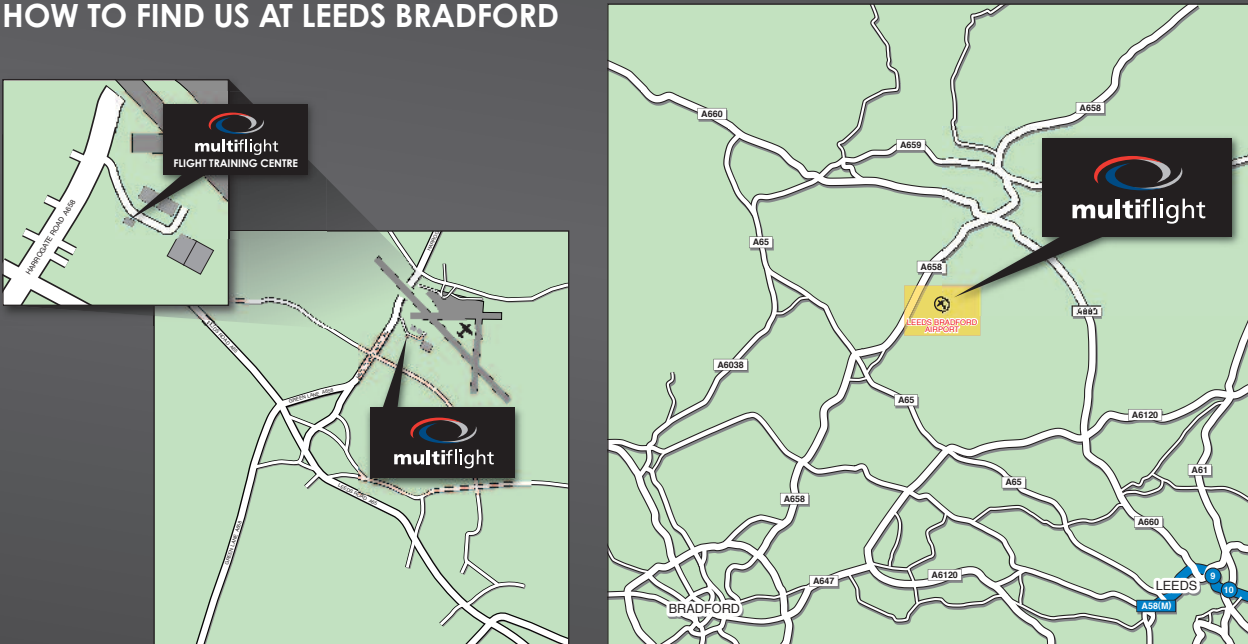
